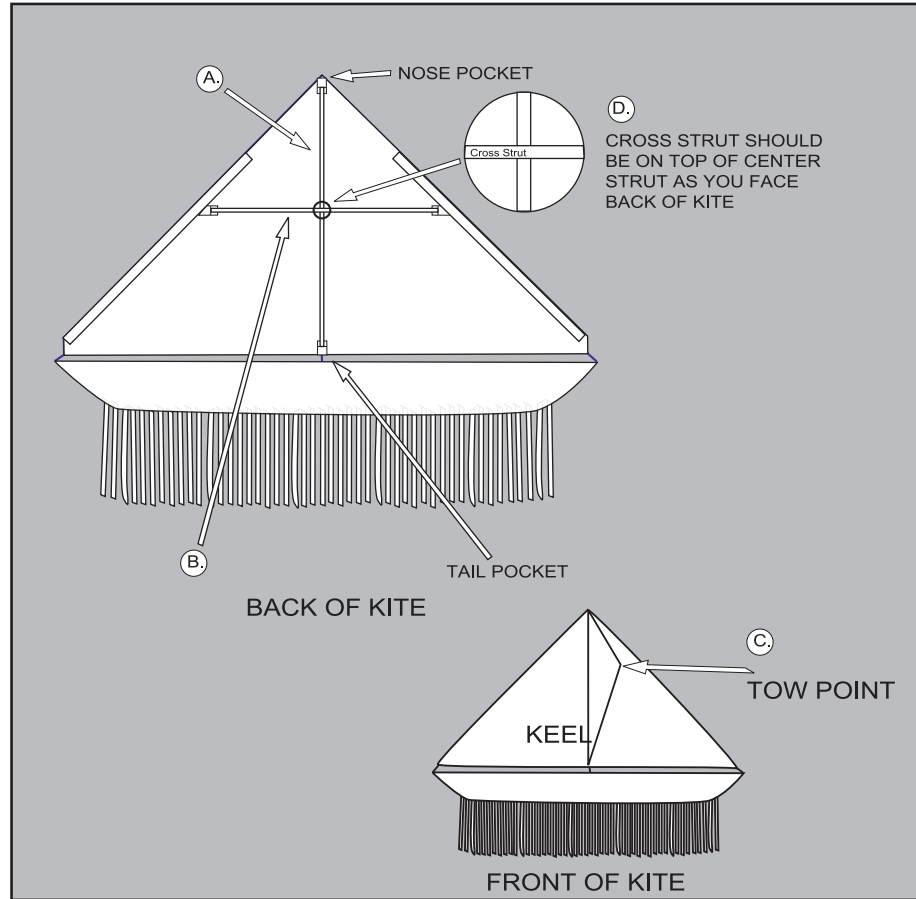
assembly instructions

Step 1:
Insert center strut into nose & tail pockets (A).

Step 2:
Insert cross strut into cross strut pocket (B).

Step 3:
Attach flying line to bridle loop on front of the kite. (C).

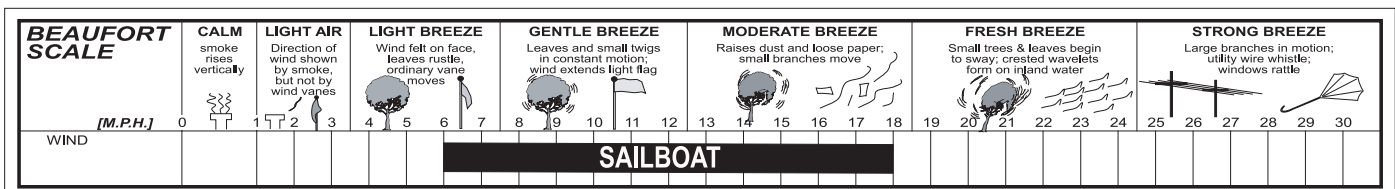
Note:
Cross strut should be on top of center strut as you face back of kite (D).



FLIGHT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Attach flying line to Tow Loop.
- Have a friend stand about 75 ft. downwind from you and hold the kite with its Leading Edge pointed towards the sky.
- As the wind catches the kite, signal your friend to release it while you bring in the line with long steady pulls.
- Slowly let out more line as the kite flies upward.

OPTIMUM WIND CONDITIONS FOR SAILBOAT



Note: Wind conditions aloft may vary considerably from those found near ground level.
